RESOLUTION R-2022-39

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2022 FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley ("Town") Town Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and,

WHEREAS, the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the Town from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the Town Council demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley, Utah, duly called, noticed, and held on the 9th day of August, 2022, a motion to adopt the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan was proposed, seconded, and accepted by majority vote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley adopts the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, which is attached hereto.

PASSED this 9th day of August, 2022. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage and after the required publication.
