**WHEREAS**, adoption by the Town Council demonstrates their commitment to the hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.

**WHEREAS,** at a meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley, Utah, duly called, noticed, and held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2022, a motion to adopt the 2022 Five County Association of Governments Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan was proposed, seconded, and accepted by majority vote.
