A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CAPITALIZATION POLICY FOR ASSETS

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley ("Town") is a Utah municipal corporation; and,

WHEREAS, the Town is required to prescribe uniform accounting and reporting procedures in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles pursuant to Utah Code Section 10-5-105; and,

WHEREAS, certain expenditures for assets above a certain threshold and useful life should be capitalized and depreciated; and

WHEREAS, the Town has determined the threshold to be \$5,000.00 and with a useful life of one year or more; and

WHEREAS, The Town Council of Apple Valley held a public meeting duly called, noticed and held on the 17th day of May 2023; and,

WHEREAS, a motion was duly made, seconded, and accepted by majority vote in regard to capitalization; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Apple Valley, Utah, that the capitalization policy threshold shall be \$5,000.00 with a useful life of one year or more.
