RESOLUTION R-2021-11
A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING PUBLIC UTILITY STRUCTURES FROM BUILDING
HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley ("Apple Valley") is in the process of creating new public infrastructure of water tanks and power substations.

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley is in negotiations to provide a new substation to be solely paid for by Rocky Mountain Power for the benefit of Apple Valley residents.

WHEREAS, the Town of Apple Valley will assist in the location of said water tanks and substations to ensure the locality of such improvements is in harmony with the Town's infrastructure, plans and improvement.

WHEREAS, the Apple Valley Town Council desires to exempt all utility structures from building height restrictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, at a meeting of the legislative body of the Town of Apple Valley, Utah, duly called, noticed and held on the 15th day of December 2021, and upon motion duly made and seconded,

BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Power substations are exempt from any and all building height restrictions.

SECTION 2: Public infrastructure are exempt from any and all building height restrictions.
