DESCRIPTION

Dump Truck

- 1978 6 Cylinder Mack Dump Truck
- Diesel Fuel

Water Truck

- 1984 Peterbilt three axle Cummins Diesel
- Vehicle was converted in 1996 to a 4,000 gallon water truck with interior water valve system
- Dual rear differentials (heavy duty) 4 to 1 ratio
- Berkeley water pump and complete water distribution system

BID FORMAT

All proposals shall include an **original** and **six (6)** copies. Bids must be organized to comply with and include the following:

1. One page Letter including the following:

- Individual bidder's name, address, telephone number, and email address.
- Asset being bid upon.
- Amount of bid. Must be no less than \$2,000.
- The name that the title will be put in.

BID INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The timeline of the bid process is as follows:
 - Distribution: The notice will be distributed on June 9, 2022
 - Submissions Due Date: Bids must be delivered to the Town Clerk no later than 3:00 p.m., July 19, 2022, at Town Hall 1777 N. Meadowlark Dr, Apple Valley, UT 84737.
 - Bid Opening: Town Council will open and review all bids at the regular meeting on July 20, 2022.
 - Award of Bid: It is anticipated the award will be given at the Town meeting on July 20, 2022. However, the Town Council reserves the right to award within two (2) weeks or at the next regular meeting of opening bids, whichever is later. Written notification by letter or email regarding the outcome of the award will be sent after the award is announced. Every effort will be made to administer the bid process in accordance with the terms and dates discussed in these instructions. However, the Town reserves the right to modify the bid process and dates as deemed necessary.

2. Standard Procurement Process

- The Town reserves the right to reject any or all bids and select the best bid in the opinion of the Town.
- A representative is required to be present.

OTHER INFORMATION

- 1. Truck must be removed from the site one week after the award.
- 2. A certified check will be required for payment
