Proclamation

WHEREAS, in 1872, J. Sterling Morton proposed to the Nebraska Board of Agriculture that a special day should be set aside for the planting of trees; and

WHEREAS, this holiday, Arbor Day, first was observed with the planting of more than a million trees in Nebraska, and it now is observed throughout the nation and the world on the final Friday in April; and

WHEREAS, trees can reduce the erosion of our topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees in our City increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, beautify our community, and are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas City has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the National Arbor Day Foundation for the 27th year in a row and so desires to continue its tree-planting ways; and

WHEREAS, first celebrated 50 years ago in 1970, Earth Day is an annual event celebrated around the world on **April 22** to demonstrate support for environmental protection and it now includes events coordinated globally by the Earth Day Network in more than 193 countries; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Rogers, Mayor of the City of Arkansas City, Kansas, do hereby proclaim that **Thursday, April 22, 2021**, is

EARTH DAY

in the City of Arkansas City, Kansas, and I furthermore do also hereby proclaim that **Friday, April 30, 2021**, is

ARBOR DAY

in the City of Arkansas City, Kansas, and urge all citizens to observe both days with appropriate ceremonies and observances during “**Earth Week**,” which this year is observed on **April 22-30, 2021**, including participating in **Spring Cleanup Day** on **Saturday, April 24, 2021**, and taking advantage of **Citywide Pickup Week** services on **April 26-30, 2021**. Together, we can help clean up our community!
