WHEREAS, the Town of Ashland City wishes to discontinue said temporary employment period for all of its new employees hired after the effective date of this Resolution; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the Town of Ashland_City hereby authorizes a discontinuance of its present temporary employment period for all new employees hired after the effective date of this Resolution.
