

**ORDINANCE #**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF ASHLAND CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN THE SALARIES OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS, COMMITTEES AND BOARDS SUBSEQUENT TO THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council has determined that the public interest can best be served by amending the city’s municipal code in order to increase the existing salaries of the Mayor, Council, Beer Board, Liquor Board, Budget Committee, Parks Board, Planning Commission, and Board of Zoning provided that such increase shall not become effective until after next election.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Ashland City, Tennessee, that the Municipal Code shall be amended as follows:

1. Amend Title One (1), Chapter 1, Section 104 and 105, Compensation.

“The salaries of each Council member/Committee member shall remain at \$93.75 per meeting.”

2. Amend Title One (1), Chapter 2, Section 203, Compensation.

“The salary of the mayor shall be \$30,000 per year.”

3. Amend Title One (1) Chapter 2, Section 204, Compensation.

“The salary of the Board of Appeals shall remain at \$62.50 per meeting.”

4. Amend Title Two (2), Chapter 2, Section 216, Compensation.

“The salary of the Parks Board shall remain at \$62.50 per meeting.”

5. Amend Title Fourteen (14), Chapter 1, Section 14-101, Compensation.

“The salary of the Planning Board shall remain at \$62.50 per meeting.”

Such amendments not to be effective until September 1, 2024.
