CALL TO ORDER

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Chairman Michael W. Smith.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

2. November 23, 2021 minutes

PARTNER REPORTS

He also stated the fencing at the tennis courts would be replaced with new fencing and will be ordering new signs as well.

3. Music on Main 2022

4. Movie in the Park 2022

It was stated the board will be doing movies in the park this calendar year and Ms. Jamie Winslett will send out the available movie list and the board will pick all dates well before hand including the Trunk-Or-Treat event. Mr. Sampson stated he will be asking more people to assist with the movie events and it was suggested a volunteer list be made where the community can sign up to assist.

5. Park Activities 2022

Mr. Smith stated he had a conversation with Mayor Allen and he would like to see more music events in park, and possible consider using Caldwell Park for events.

OTHER

Ms. Winslett stated she would like to see beautification at Johns Park by planting sunflowers in certain spots along the walking track.
