LETTER FROM THE CHIEF

06/01/2025

Since we are in the burning season, I would like to send out a reminder to everyone to please practice fire safety. If you need a burn permit you may print one on our website. www.atlastownshipfire.org. Also, be sure to read it and follow the rules for burning. Remember to check our website and Facebook page prior to lighting any fire to make sure there is not a burning ban in effect.

Due to increased travel and the presence of teen drivers who are inexperienced, June through July are the most dangerous months for traffic accidents. In the past month we have responded to five motor vehicle accidents, four of them on M-15. Please pay extra attention to your surroundings while on the road.

The Atlas Township Fire Department is accepting applications for firefighters. We are looking for anyone 18 or older who lives in Atlas Township and would like to help the community they live in. No experience needed. We will pay for all the training. The fire academy begins in the fall.
