City of Augusta and Georgia Department of Transportation standards and specifications. 7. issuance of a building permit for lot 201 the applicant shall be responsible for the installation and cost of a traffic signal at the intersection of Manchester Drive and Tobacco Road and will collaborate with Augusta Engineering for cost sharing. 8. The first phase of the development shall take place near the proposed entrance along Windsor Spring Road. 9. Construction traffic access via Manchester Drive must be kept at a minimum. 10. A minimum of 4 entrances are required for this subdivision based on the number of lots shown on the concept plan. The applicant must request a variance from the Land Subdivision Regulations to reduce the required number of entrances. The variance must be approved before submitting a development plan for review. 11. This project shall comply with all development standards and regulations, including but not limited to the Tree Ordinance, set forth by the City of Augusta, GA at the time of development.
