Background:	<p>On December 5, 2023, the Augusta, GA Commission approved to accept an award from Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA) in the amount of \$58,500.00 to enhance the Richmond County Sheriff's Office Bomb Canine Unit.</p> <p>The Richmond County Sheriff's Office K9 Division is requesting the purchase of one 2024 Dodge Durango to replace asset #219015, a 2019 Ford Explorer, that was totaled in a vehicle accident in December 2023.</p>
Analysis:	<p>The Dodge manufacture is no longer accepting 2024 Dodge Durango orders due to the pricing being closed. Thomson Motor Center has a 2024 Dodge Durango in their stock inventory that is available for purchase. Upon the vendors request, the Procurement Department issued a LOI (Letter of Intent) to secure the purchase of one 2024 Dodge Durango at a price of \$54,546 from Thomson Motor Center.</p>
