between the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) and Augusta, Georgia for inventory and replacement of water service lines throughout the

drinking water system and the Resolution of the Governing Body.

Background:

The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan will be used in conjunction

with other department resources to refine the inventory and implement

replacement of the Augusta Drinking Water System's service lines to comply with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Revised Lead and Copper Rule for

water service line materials.

Analysis: Augusta Utilities Department has been awarded a \$11,250,000.00 loan through

the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) to refine and compile a Drinking

Water System Service Line Inventory and make the necessary service line

replacements to the water system. These funds will allow Augusta Utilities to field investigate, provide public outreach & education, deploy resources and assets for

modeling, and the installation of the water service lines identified for

replacement.

Financial Impact: This loan is in the amount of \$11,250,000.00 with principal forgiveness funding in

the amount of \$5,625,000.00.

Alternatives: Deny the loan agreement.
