Caption: Motion to approve the 2023 Comprehensive Plan Update: Envision Augusta

Background: Georgia incentivizes comprehensive planning by allowing cities and counties

with DCA-approved comprehensive plans access to a special package of financial resources to aid in implementing their plans. This includes Community Development Block Grants (CDBG), water and sewer loans from the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA), economic development funding from the OneGeorgia Authority, and a variety of other programs from DCA and partner agencies (a detailed list is available in the "Fact Sheets" section, below). Eligibility for this package of incentives is

called Qualified Local Government (QLG) status.

Analysis: Every 5-years we are required to update comprehensive plan. The current

plan was approved in 2018. DCA has reviewed the 2023 update and

recommended it for approval.

Financial Impact: If approved, Augusta is eligible for grants and aid from the state and federal

government.

Alternatives: If approval is not completed by October 31, 2023, Augusta would lose its

qualifying local government status and the funding associated with it.
