Caption: Motion to approve the purchase of one non-CDL crane truck ITB 25-204, at a total

cost of \$241,677 from Tom Graddy Enterprises of Beech Island, SC for the Augusta

Utilities Department.

**Background:** Due to the increasing workload and operational demands, Utilities 'current fleet of

F550 Class V trucks has experienced ongoing maintenance issues, including frontend wear, tire blowouts, and frequent brake failures. These recurring problems indicate that the existing vehicles may be operating beyond their intended capacity

leading to excessive strain and downtime.

To address these challenges, Utilities has requested to purchase a truck to upgrade the class V to a class VI truck for larger tasks. The larger vehicle will provide a

stronger suspension system and higher load capacity will aid in reducing

maintenance frequency and extending the vehicle's service life.

Analysis: The Procurement Department published a competitive bid using the Demand Star

application for a 2025/2026 Truck, Non-CDL Crane. Invitations to bid were sent to 17 vendors with 3 compliant bids received. Tom Graddy Enterprises' bid offer is

the lowest compliant bid that meets all the requirements of the specifications.
