under the ECSDC Grant Program between GEFA and Augusta, Georgia for the preliminary study and design services as it relates to evaluation of the presence of

PFAS in the groundwater system of Augusta.

Background: The ECSDC Grant Program established under the Water Infrastructure

Improvements for the Nation (WIIN) Act Grant is designed to help public water systems reduce exposure to PFAS. This grant funding will benefit Augusta in compliance with Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) and maintaining water quality.

Analysis: Augusta Utilities Department has been awarded a \$3,720,000.00 grant through

the ECSDC Grant Program. The grant funds will support preliminary activities including sampling and analysis of PFAS compounds, evaluation of treatment alternatives, and development of design plans for future treatment improvements

and infrastructure upgrades at Augusta's drinking water treatment facilities.

Financial Impact: This grant is in the amount of \$3,720,000.00.
