**SUBJECT:** Emergency Request for two 30-inch valves for Basin 6 & 7

---

This is an emergency request for Two – 30 inch valves for our water basins at the Highland Water Treatment Plant, current the 2 valves in the system are failing and it requires operations to have to shut down both basins when cleaning is required cutting our production by 30%, with these 2 new valves only one basin has to be taken out of service cutting production down to just 15%. The other reason is the valves of this size are hard to come by since the pandemic, without a lead time of 26 weeks, we have a vendor who has 2 on the shelf and would not be subject to any increase in tariff pricing.
