Dear Mayor Johnson:

The Department has approved the City's funding assistance request for repairing drainage structures/pipes, strain poles, and guardrail repairs to roads damaged by Hurricane Helene. The Department will commit up to \$450,873 or 90% of the project cost, whichever is less. The project will be funded out of the Department's Local Maintenance & Improvement Grant (LMIG) Program. These funds will be in addition to any other LMIG funds allocated to the City.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AFFIDAVIT AND CERTIFICATION

All projects identified on the Project list shall be constructed in accordance with the Department's Standard Specifications of Transportation Systems (Current Edition), Supplemental Specifications (Current Edition), and Special Provisions.
