Background:	The purpose of this project is based upon the need to replace the existing ARFF facility to better support ongoing operational, safety, and maintenance requirements and to reduce ARFF response times. The existing facility requires significant ongoing maintenance, is operationally inefficient, and has exceeded its useful life. The objective is to complete a preliminary Feasibility Study to confirm the viability of the proposed ARFF replacement and relocation project. The study will define space needs, assess site constraints, develop footprint and floor plan concepts, and establish a clearly defined concept design, preliminary construction budget, and high-level project schedule to support future project advancement. The project is programmed for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 and is proposed to be funded via AGS Airport Infrastructure Grants. The estimated construction budget for the entire project is approximately Twelve Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$12,600,000.00).
Analysis:	Continuous improvement and expansion of the Airport remains a high priority for the community, City, and staff. The current estimated cost is \$12,600,000. This Amendment has been reviewed by Airport Legal Counsel, Mr. Robert Kerr.
