Parks & Recreation LWCF grant pre-application

Caption: Motion to ratify a resolution for the pre-application for the Land and Water

Conservation Fund (LWCF).

Background: The Land and Water Conservation Fund grant is a federal grant supporting

projects and developments that safeguard natural areas and increase recreational opportunities. Funding requires a 50 percent match and the maximum funding amount is \$1M. In order to be considered for the grant application, a pre-application is required, indicating the local government's

support.

Analysis: The Parks and Recreation Department intends to participate in the pre-

application process for the grant with a project at Diamond Lakes Regional

Park. If approved and the Department is awarded the grant, Parks &

Recreation will improve Diamond Lakes Regional Park and establish a multi-

usage trail system through and around the park. The trail system can be utilized for walking, running, inline skating, and biking, with different levels of intensity and different lengths from 1 mile to 5 miles. The trail would connect the old raceway to the park system and lead past the lake areas and

through other natural areas within the park.

Financial Impact: The overall cost for the project is estimated at \$1,000,000.00. Augusta's

match would be approximately \$500,000. The actual cost and the resulting 50 percent match will be determined during the pre-application. Funding is

available through SPLOST 8 Park Improvement projects.
