Background: On 4/18/23 the Commission voted unanimously to approve an ordinance

amendment for the management of Community Cats that would reduce the number of cats impounded and euthanized. This approval came with an agreement on record from Best Friends Animal Society that they would fund

the program completely for 3 years.

Analysis: Under the current ordinance Animal Services has to intake over 2,000 cats

annually and euthanize approximately 50% of them. The Community Cat Ordinance amendment should drastically reduce our intake and euthanasia numbers which will result in less staff hours allocated for cat care, cat

complaints, and cat euthanasia.

Financial Impact: Reduction in the total cost of care and euthanasia of cats annually.
