### NPDES Storm Water Monitoring & Inspections Contract 1-Year Extension

<b>Caption:</b>	Approve contract amendment to Cranston Engineering Group, PC for RFP Item #20-260 NPDES Storm Water Monitoring and Inspections for one (1) additional year.
<b>Background:</b>	Cranston Engineering Group, P.C. has managed the project since approved by the Commission on November 17 <sup>th</sup> , 2020. The purpose of this contract is to ensure compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit requirements, including storm water monitoring, inspections, reporting, and related regulatory documentation for Augusta Utilities Department projects. AUD seeks to extend this contract time to develop a new RFP for these services. More than 80% of the originally allocated funds remain unexpended therefore this is a zero-cost time extension only.
<b>Analysis:</b>	Augusta Utilities Department evaluated Cranston's services and find them fair and reasonable to be continued for this additional timeframe.
<b>Financial Impact:</b>	Funds were previously approved with remaining balance anticipated to complete this contract period in account: G/L 507043490-5212115 and J/L 81000010-5212115.
<b>Alternatives:</b>	No alternatives are recommended.
<b>Recommendation:</b>	Augusta Utilities recommends approving the contract extension for 1 year to continue these services while allowing time to issue a new RFP.
