Background:	The FY2023 Emergency Management Performance Grant is a grant provided through GEMHSA to support the implementation of the National Preparedness System by supporting the building, sustainment, and delivery of core capabilities essential to achieving the National Preparedness Goal of a secure and resilient Nation. The purpose of the EMPG program is to provide Federal grants to states to assist state, local, territorial, and tribal governments in preparing for hazards.
Analysis:	EMPG grant will fund EMA personnel salaries.
Financial Impact:	The EMPG requires a minimum 50% (cash or in-kind) match.
