Changing to Full Restaurant with Sunday Sales for Alcohol License

<b>Caption:</b>	Alpha Louis for Tiffany's Eatery Requesting to become a Full Restaurant with Sunday Sales to existing Consumption on Premises for Liquor, Beer and Wine Alcohol License. Located at 828 Broad Street. District 1, Super District 9
<b>Background:</b>	<p>Tiffany's Eatery was approved for a consumption on premises liquor, beer and wine alcohol license for a Limited Restaurant/Lounge on April 16, 2024. When they applied for the license, they did not request a Full Restaurant eating establishment with Sunday sales on the application.</p> <p>For existing businesses to be eligible to change their status for Sunday sales, they must provide documentation that shows that at least 50 percent of the business's total annual gross income of food and beverage sales comes from prepared meals and food on-premises from the previous calendar year.</p>
<b>Analysis:</b>	The business has been open and closed several times in the past and has not been able to provide enough documentation to determine that the 50 percent on-premises food sales requirement has been met.
<b>Financial Impact:</b>	Applicant would pay a fee of \$1,245.00
<b>Alternatives:</b>	N/A
<b>Recommendation:</b>	Staff recommend denial as the applicant has been unable to provide substantial evidence that the current business is meeting the required 50 percent on-premises food sale for the business within the previous year.
