acceptance under the Emerging Contaminants, Small and Disadvantaged Communities (ECSDC) Grant Program between the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) and Augusta, Georgia for the preliminary study and design services as it relates to evaluation of the presence of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in the groundwater system of Augusta. Approval of this item will include the ability for electronic signature by

Augusta.

Background: The (ECSDC) Grant Program was established under the Water Infrastructure

Improvements for the Nation (WIIN) Act. The grant is designed to help public water systems reduce exposure to (PFAS). This grant funding will benefit Augusta in compliance with Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) and maintaining water

quality.

Analysis: Augusta Utilities Department has been awarded a \$3,720,000.00 grant through the

ECSDC Grant Program. The grant funds will support preliminary activities including sampling and analysis of PFAS compounds, evaluation of treatment alternatives, and development of design plans for future treatment improvements and infrastructure upgrades at Augusta's drinking water treatment facilities.

Financial Impact: This grant is in the amount of \$3,720,000.00 with no local match.

Alternatives: No alternative is proposed.

Recommendation: Approve authorization of a grant agreement and funding acceptance under

the Emerging Contaminants, Small and Disadvantaged Communities (ECSDC) Grant Program between the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority (GEFA) and Augusta, Georgia for the preliminary study and design services as it relates to evaluation of the presence of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) in the groundwater system of Augusta.
