Dear Mr. Witcher and Mr. McCrary,

Thank you for your response to RFP 25-174. On August 14, 2025, Augusta provided a request to enter into contract negotiations with your company in reference to Category 4 of RFP 25-174. Please be advised that Augusta has requested to cease negotiations with your company due to the delayed response from your company. The request to cease negotiations is based on the lack of responsiveness from your company since the initial decision to enter into negotiations was made as detailed below:

- AUD and Procurement met with your company on August 13th to notify them they were selected for Category 4 of the RFP. On this same date your company was provided a list of questions to answer and were requested to provide a sample contract for review by AUD's attorney in preparation to submit an agenda item for Commission approval. Your company was directed to respond by August 19th.
- On August 21st at 9:47 a.m. the Procurement Department emailed your company to inform you that we had not received a response to the questions or a sample contract. You were directed to respond by 2:00 p.m. on August 22nd.
- On September 4th at 3:45 p.m. the Procurement Department emailed your company to inform them that we had still not received a response, and that per an earlier phone call they were directed to provide a response by the end of day on September 10th.
- On September 16th the procurement department again contacted your company by phone to inform them we had still not received a response.
- On September 16th at 4:15 p.m., your company provided an incomplete response to the
 questions and a sample contract. In their response they did not respond appropriately to
 the question of a parts discount that was also clearly required in the initial RFP response.

For these reasons, Augusta has determined that a long-term partnership with your company for our Advanced Metering Project is not in the best interests of Augusta. The user department, Augusta Utilities Department, has requested to move forward with awarding Category 4 of RFP 25-174, Water Meters, to the next most responsive vendor.
