

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BALDWIN COUNTY, GEORGIA, APPROVING A REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE BALDWIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, REQUESTING THAT ITS LOCAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION HAVE SUCH REDISTRICTING PLAN INTRODUCED AS LOCAL LEGISLATION AT THE 2022 REGULAR SESSION OF THE GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 2020 Decennial Census has been completed and the results thereof have been submitted to the Board of Commissioners of Baldwin County, Georgia;

WHEREAS, such 2020 Census reflects that the population of Baldwin County decreased by 1,921 to 45,720;

WHEREAS, the County Commission Districts for elected members of the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners must be redrawn in order to comply with federal and state guidelines, including the principle of "one person, one vote"; and

WHEREAS, the Baldwin County redistricting plan and maps were prepared by the in-house GIS Department and the maps were submitted to the Reapportionment Office for review and certification; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has considered public input on the redistricting plan, prior to the adoption of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to submit a proposed redistricting plan to its local legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly so that such redistricting plan can be approved by the General Assembly at its 2022 regular session and then signed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, after considering public input, the principle of "one person, one vote", and other relevant matters, the Baldwin County Board of Commissioners has determined the most appropriate redistricting plan for the Baldwin County Commissioners and citizens of Baldwin County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, - acting in its capacity as the governing authority of Baldwin County, as follows:

(1) The Board of Commissioners hereby approves the redistricting plan attached as Exhibit "A".

(2) The Board of Commissioners hereby requests that its local legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly draft and introduce during the 2022 regular session of the Georgia General Assembly such redistricting plan for passage by the Georgia General Assembly and signing by the Governor.

(3) This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
