### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BALLWIN TO APPLY FOR A MUNICIPAL PARKS GRANT TO HELP PAY FOR A NEW PLAYGROUND AT THE POINTE

---

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ballwin deems it necessary to further improve a public recreational amenity, more specifically known as The Pointe Playground, to serve its citizens and to address the priorities reflected in the 2019 Parks Master Plan and Community Surveys.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

1. An application is hereby submitted under the Municipal Parks Grant program in the county of St. Louis for a grant-in-aid to cover some of the costs of the project, reimbursable by the Commission upon successful completion by the City.
2. The project proposal is hereby submitted to the Municipal Parks Grant Commission.
3. The Governing body hereby authorizes City Administrator Eric Sterman to sign and execute the necessary documents for forwarding the project proposal application and later execute an agreement for a grant-in-aid from the Municipal Parks Grant Commission.
4. If a grant is awarded, the City of Ballwin will enter into an agreement or contract with the Commission regarding this grant.

## **Memo**

**RE:** Resolution of Support for Municipal Park Grant Application

**Department/Program:** Parks and Recreation

**Explanation:**

The City intends to apply for a municipal park grant to support funding for improvements for the playground at The Pointe at Ballwin Commons. Improvements include complete demolition of the current playground, and installation with a fully ADA compliant playground with several added “inclusive” play elements, new turf surfacing in main playground pod and new engineered wood fiber surfacing under new swingset. Ample shade and all round fencing will be constructed. Feedback from the community was solicited and used in the design of the new playground. The Parks and Recreation Citizen Advisory Commission also provided feedback at their May 18 meeting. We anticipate the grant award to be \$574,750 with the City committing \$30,250 as a match for the grant.
