**AN ORDINANCE ADDING THE DEFINITION OF EMERGENCY VEHICLE IN
SECTION 1.2 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

WHEREAS, recent amendments to state traffic laws have revised the definition of “emergency vehicle” (HB1606 2022); and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to amend the companion City ordinance in keeping with new state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF BALLWIN, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The definition of “emergency vehicle” in Section 1.2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ballwin is hereby added, to read as follows:

A vehicle operated by the State Highway Patrol, the State Water Patrol, the Missouri Capitol Police, a Conservation Agent or a State, County or municipal Park Ranger, those vehicles operated by enforcement personnel of the State Highways and Transportation Commission, Police Department or Fire District, Sheriff, Constable or Deputy Sheriff, Federal Law Enforcement Officer authorized to carry firearms and to make arrests for violations of the laws of the United States, traffic officer or Coroner or by a privately owned emergency vehicle company.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
