PROGRAMMING:

On Tuesday, November 19th, the library began building 300 graham cracker houses in preparation for Open House. Building was completed on Wednesday, November 27th.

Volunteers have been crucial in the building of the graham cracker houses. Roughly twenty adult volunteers have given their time to build houses, and Youth Services Librarian Eva Bernal held a Teen Volunteers Building party that took place on Tuesday, November 26th. The event brought together seven dedicated teen volunteers who helped make the evening a success. By the end of the night, the total number of houses built was brought up to 284. Many of these enthusiastic adult and teen volunteers plan to volunteer at the upcoming Open House.

On Saturday, December 7th, Bastrop-local Brad Weber will give a presentation on German prisoners of war that were incarcerated at Camp Swift during the Second World War. This talk will focus on the arrival of the famed Afrika Korps prisoners at Camp Swift, discuss aspects of their captivity and experiences of their time in Bastrop County until their eventual release in 1946. Brad Weber holds a master's degree in military history and is a volunteer at the Bastrop County Historical Society Museum specializing in Camp Swift history.
