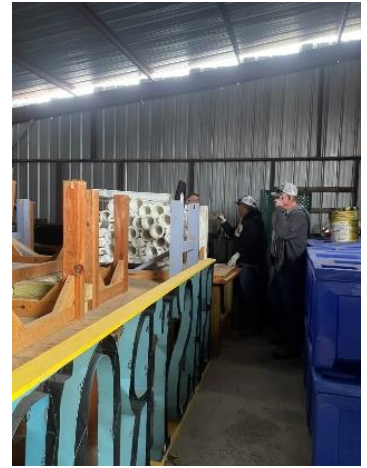
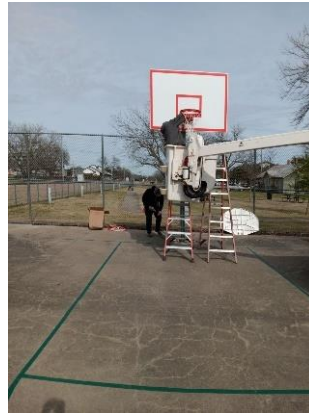

- Parks Crews repainted faded trash cans in various parks.
- Parks Crews assembled new benches and tables that were installed in Kerr Park.
- Parks Crews installed new backboards at all basketball courts in Fisherman's, Bob Bryant, and Kerr Park.
- Parks Crews completed landscaping maintenance at the Little League Baseball Fields.
- Parks Crews continued cleaning and painting trash cans and fences in various parks and in downtown.
- Parks Crews cleaned and cleared trash at the Pine Street dumpsters.
- Parks Crews posted health notices in parks regarding the Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI).
- Parks Crews added mulch to some of the picnic tables areas at Fisherman's Park.
- Parks Crews installed Purple Martin Houses at City Hall and in Bob Bryant Park.
- Parks Crews cleaned, cleared and organized storage areas at the Yard and at the Farmer's Market.
- Parks Crews sprayed off duck and bird dropping and cleared debris from the dock area at Fisherman's Park.
