<u>BEDC Report Presentation</u>: The Main Street Program will be giving an update to the Bastrop Economic Development Corporation at the September 19, 2022 meeting. This report highlights how the \$50,000 BEDC funds were budgeted for the current fiscal year along with programming and events.

<u>Visit Bastrop Joint Presentation:</u> On September 6, 2022, Visit Bastrop and the City Council held the annual Joint Workshop to review this year's fulfillment of their contact. It should be noted that Visit Bastrop asked Council to be a visible resource to visitors when they arrive to Downtown as marketing experts and as to not duplicate efforts. We do not know what that could mean for the Main Street brand or its ownership, but we will let the Board know as we begin discussions.
