# Proactive Security + Safety Protocols

## Controlled Access

### DISTINCT ACCESS POINTS

- Fully recorded, secure ID validation of all visitors and contractors
- LIMITED ACCESS AREAS: granted with proper, registered ID
- RESTRICTED ACCESS AREAS: authorized personnel only

**INTEGRATED SOFTWARE** monitors location of personnel and registered guests throughout duration of stay

## Product Safety + Anti-diversion

- All products packaged in childproof containers
- Barcoded and labeled with comprehensive content, testing and safety warnings for traceability and inventory management
- Seed-to-sale traceability from manufacturer to patient end-user
- Weekly and Monthly Inventory Audit

## Surveillance Coverage

### ON-SITE SECURITY PERSONNEL

To prevent:

- Suspicious activity
- Public consumption
- Loitering

### 24/7 CAMERA SURVEILLANCE

- INTERNAL: Every inch of the facility
- EXTERNAL: 30ft radius of facility
- State Police and State Regulators granted full access to cameras

## Public Considerations

- Carbon filtration system eliminates odor transfer.
- Stand-alone building
- Absolutely zero on-site consumption
- All employees and registered visitors must be aged 21+

# Minnesota's Medical Cannabis Program



- Minnesota Department of Health
  - Office of Medical Cannabis (OMC)
- Requires a qualifying condition
- Requires a MN licensed health care practitioner to certify

- Only two companies allowed and licensed as medical cannabis cultivators and distributors
- Limited accessible locations for patients
- One of the most restrictive medical cannabis programs in the United States

# Qualifying Conditions

---

- **17 qualifying conditions**
  - **Patients can be certified for more than one condition**
  - **Top three qualifying conditions are:**
    1. **Intractable Pain**
    2. **Chronic Pain**
    3. **Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder**
- Intractable pain
  - Cancer
  - Glaucoma
  - HIV/AIDS
  - Tourette syndrome
  - PTSD
  - Muscle spasms
  - Epilepsy and seizures
  - Inflammatory Bowel Disease
  - Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)
  - Terminal illnesses
  - Autism
  - Obstructive Sleep Apnea
  - Alzheimer's disease
  - Chronic pain
  - Sickle cell disease
  - Chronic motor or vocal tic disorder

# Joining The Program

---

- 1 Identify your qualifying medical condition.
- 2 Find a health care practitioner who certifies conditions (we have a list on our website and so does MN DOH).
- 3 Complete your enrollment application, provide proof of ID and pay the annual fee within 90 days of certification.
- 4 Receive your approval email from the Office of Medical Cannabis.
- 5 Meet with a pharmacist and pick up your medical cannabis at any RISE Dispensary.

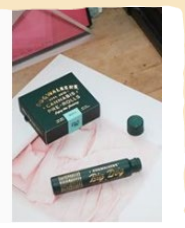

**NEW CANNABIS**
