

City of Baxter Dog Park Rules & Regulations

- Dog owners are legally responsible for their dogs and assume all responsibility for injuries, or damage caused by the owner's dog while on public premises.
- 2. The park is closed from 10:00 p.m. 6:00 a.m.
- The fenced-in dog park play area is the only permitted off-leash area. Dogs must be leashed, except when within the fenced-in dog park play area.
- Dog owners must always have their dog in view and in control. No dog may be unattended.
- 5. Continual barking is unacceptable. Barking dogs shall be immediately removed from the park by the dog owner.
- 6. Owners shall clean up their dog's pet waste by disposing of feces properly.
- 7. Human food, dog food, dog treats and dog chew toys or other dog toys are not permitted in the fenced-in dog park play area.
- 8. Aggressive dogs are not allowed in the park. Any dogs showing signs of aggression shall be immediately removed from the premises. Dogs that are dangerous or potentially dangerous are not permitted within the park.
- 9. Dogs must display current licenses on their collars, must have current vaccinations, and be

- in healthy condition prior to entering the dog park.
- 10. Puppies under four months of age are not permitted in the dog park.
- 11. Infants and small children are not permitted in the dog park.
- 12. Female dogs in heat are not permitted in the dog park.
- 13. No alcohol is permitted.
- 14. Please keep the gates closed and help keep the park clean and in nice condition so that all may enjoy using it.
