BACKGROUND

The plans, Right of Way Certificate, and specifications have been completed and reviewed by State Aid. They have also received final review and approval from the Central Office. The project was given federal authorization to advertise and bid on June 11th, 2026.

Resolution 2026-050 to authorize the advertisement of bids for the project was adopted at the July 7th City Council Meeting. The project was advertised July 8th, 15th, and 23rd of 2026 and bids were opened on July 30th, 2026 at 10:00 AM.

The following three (3) bids were received:

Young Excavating of Hackensack, Minnesota is the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$1,489,037.63 for the 2026 CSAH 48 Trail (Highland Scenic Road) Trail Connection Project, Municipal Project No. 4140.

The total project cost estimate identified below in the Financial Implications section is based on the as-bid construction costs, costs to date, and cost participation policy that was approved with Crow Wing County.

Due to the federal funds on the project, the contract cannot be awarded until approval has been given from the MNDOT Office of Civil Rights (OCR) that the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Requirement has been met. The DBE requirement ensures that the contractor is offering equal employment opportunities. Approval was given on August 4th, 2026.

The City's portion of the project consists of \$466,122.37. Staff is proposing to utilize state aid funds to pay for the City's portion of the project. There is \$649,928.04 eligible for state aid funds on the project meaning there is \$183,805.67 of eligible state aid not being utilized.
