

I plan to seed and cover or hydroseed the repaired area with a seed mix used by the city of Baxter as well as many local landscapers from Bjerga's Feed Store in Brainerd. We have Bur Oak seedlings and saplings all over the property, which would work well in that open space. I would transplant them no less than 35 feet apart from other trees and I would also include Sugar Maples that we would purchase. Planting would happen in the Spring or Fall and we would fence or wrap the trees if needed to protect them. If trees die, they would be replaced. We would also fertilize and water them regularly. The goal would be to have the repaired area blend in with the existing trees as if it were always there, being careful to not plant too densely so the trees have adequate sunlight and space to grow.
