Monthly Fire Calls: There were 6 fire calls for service in September.

9/1/2022: Dispatched to Cobre High School to assist with the Bon Fire.

9/3/2022: Dispatched to 404 ½ Ruby Street for a gas meter that was hit by a car. Arrived on scene and called out the gas company.

9/4/2022: Dispatched to 107 S. Foy for a structure fire. Arrived on scene and found the residence fully engulfed with flames. Utilized mutual aid from Ft. Bayard and Santa Clara.

9/5/2022: Dispatched to 107 S. Foy for structure fire. Residence reignited and we had to extinguish it.

9/14/2022: Dispatched to 188 North Hurley Road for a Structure fire. Arrived on scene and found no fire.

9/26/2022: Dispatched to 1208 Central Ave. for a structure fire. Arrived on scene and found smoke coming from the residence. Attacked fire in back bedroom and extinguished. Utilized mutual aid from Ft. Bayard and Whiskey Creek.
