## Agenda Content:

Discuss, consider, and/or approve the selection of an engineering firm to support the 2024 Texas Community Development Block Grant Downtown Revitalization/Main Street Program application and project implementation.

## **Executive Summary of Item:**

The City is seeking to revitalize its downtown area through the 2024 Texas Community Development Block Grant-Downtown Revitalization/Main Street Program, managed by the Texas Department of Agriculture. This program aims to improve infrastructure in areas identified as deteriorated, to stimulate economic growth, improve residents' quality of life, and preserve historic districts. The City intends to apply for a \$500,000 grant from the program and will contribute a 15% match of \$75,000.

In preparation for a successful grant application and the potential project implementation, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to solicit qualifications from engineering firms. A selection review committee was appointed to score the submissions, and the scores are tallied to identify the most qualified firm that the City can negotiate a contract with. The selected firm will provide essential services for the project's planning and execution. The firm's expertise is crucial for the City to efficiently meet the program's goals and align with the city's strategic objectives.
