# REGULAR ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION, CONSIDERATION AND / OR APPROVAL

1. Discussion relative to the proposed design and construction of a new "all purpose' Aquatic Center in Bay City. Loy Sneary

Loy Sneary presented a "re-calibrated" aquatics center proposal stating that after the last meeting it became apparent that not all entities were favorable due to the price. New proposal has cut down the facility to just the covered pool and a smaller outside water park. Mr. Sneary stated that the aquatic center could attract developer, Hospital would be a tenant and financers would be the City and County. Mayor Pro Tem Childers asked what does that do to revenues and have they tried fund raising. Mr. Sneary replied that until they get some entities they have not pursued other but some private companies are interested. Councilwoman Sitz asked if there would be room to grow and Mr. Sneary replied yes. Mayor Pro Tem Childers stated that he thinks there is a need and he is interested in what the other entities have to say. Councilman Westmoreland stated that a workshop with the players to discuss needs to be done. Mayor Nelson added that Council should first determine where the City needs to be. Councilwoman Brown stated she loved the idea and recommended that Mr. Sneary look at the Tallahassee project. Councilman Folse stated that he wanted to make it clear that he is for the project but is concerned about the funding. Shawn Burkhart asked if Council would like her to get quotes on what the tax rate would look like on 2, 3. and 4 million dollar issuances.
