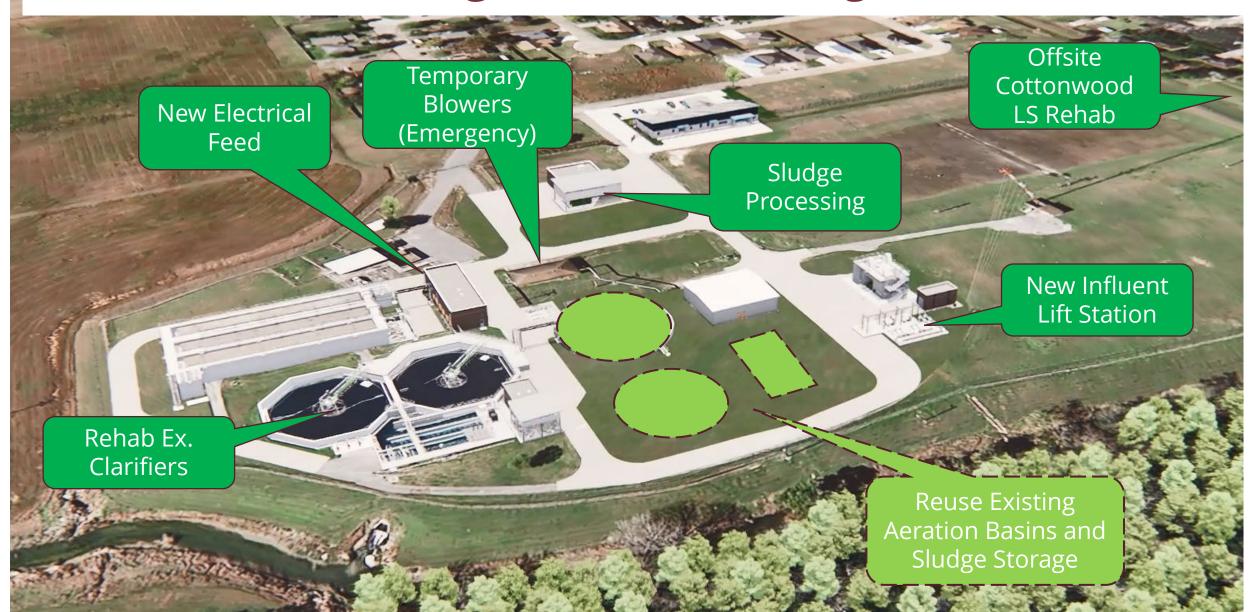

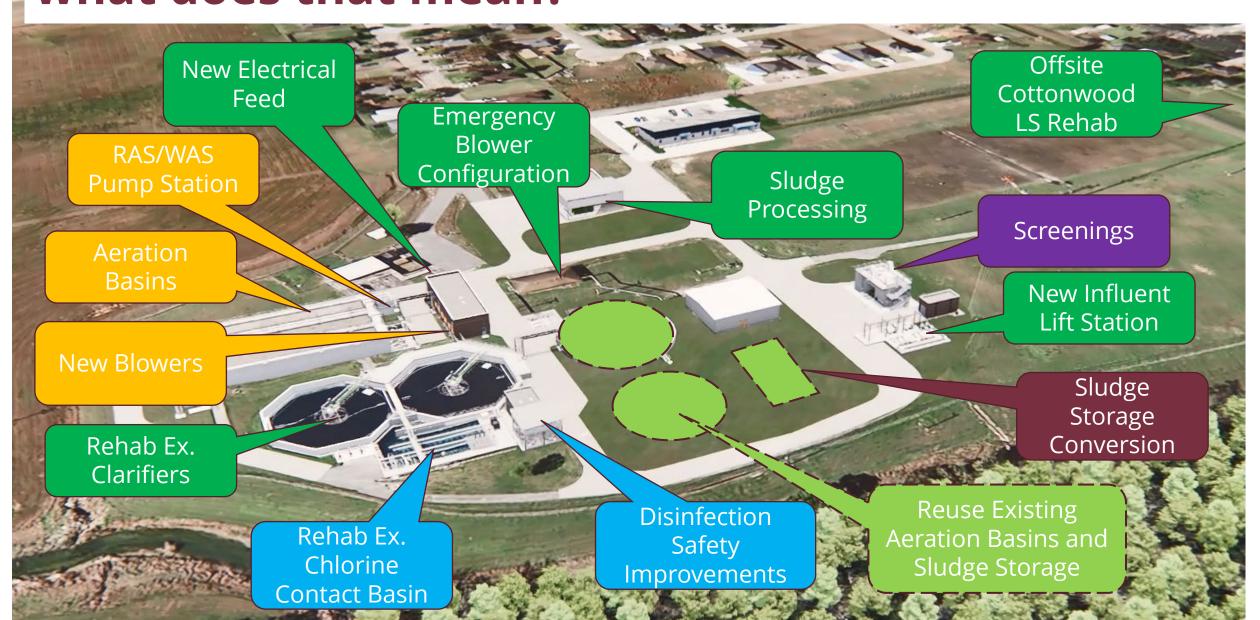


Path Forward on TWDB-Funded WWTP Scope

- April 2023

 - Issue Construction NTP
- Construction Period
 - Reduced construction period



Which improvements haven't made the cut and what does that mean?



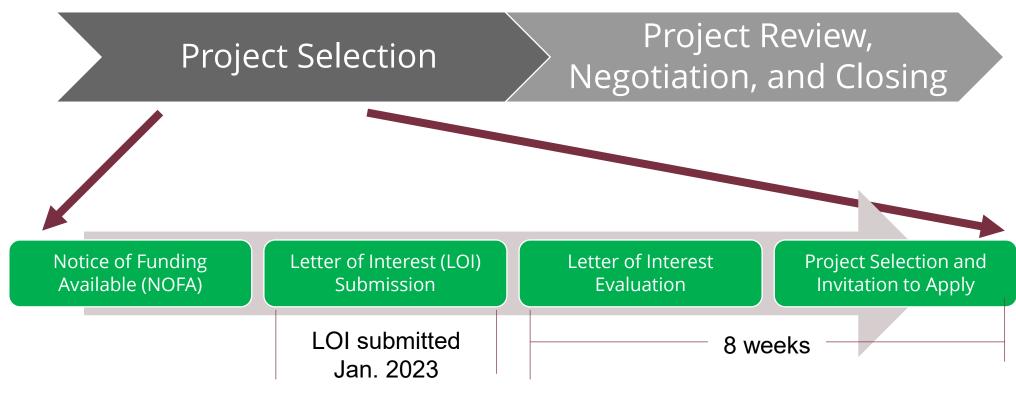
Prioritization, Design Revisions, and WIFIA funding would allow for significant improvements in plant longevity, function, and optimization

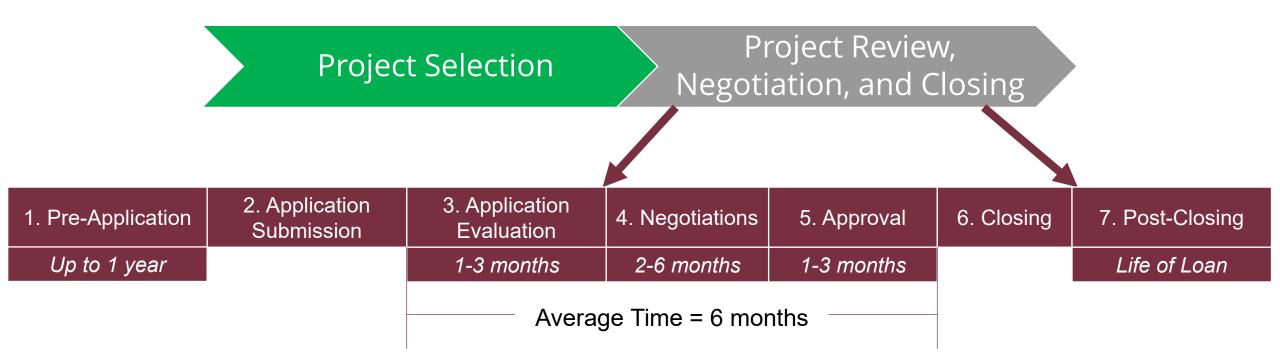
WIFIA Process - Project Selection

WIFIA Funding

- Up to \$30M is available
- Amount of loan value can be reduced through closing
- Possible to utilize less than the full amount after closing
- Funding is only available as a supplement to other funding sources at less than 80% of the project total (previously 50%)
- Can defer loan payments for up to 5 years from Substantial Completion of the project (7+ years from Contractor NTP)



Additional efforts have been made to mitigate rate impacts

The following projects have been removed from the TWDB DWSRF funding:

- 12" New Waterline Extension SH35 East: \$1,000,000
- 12" New Waterline Extension (Ph 2) SH60 North: \$1,159,000
- 12" New Waterline 12" St East: \$1,210,000
- 6" New Waterline Hillcrest Dr: \$155,000
- 12" New Waterline Extension SH60 South: \$1,354,000

Total: \$4,878,000
