KM \$500.00 cleaning deposit which is refundable when the facility is left clean and no damage occurs. If you do not clean the facility, and there are damages, your deposit will be retained to cover the cost, and you will be liable for any expenses incurred over and above the deposit paid. Cleaning includes the hallway and the restrooms.

Security Guards:

22 Security Guards are required, the number to be determined by the Beaumont Police Department for Civic Center or CRC. (# of guards on all facility rentals are subject to approval by the Beaumont Police Department). Arrangements may be made with a private security firm. A copy of the contract must be provided to this office.

THE GUARD MUST BE LICENSED, BONDED AND IN UNIFORM.

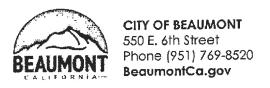
Alcoholic Beverages:
