SUBJECT: Approve the First Extension of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Chemical Supply Contract with HASA, Inc.

Background and Analysis:

City staff issued a request for bids in May 2020, for chemical supplies required to operate the new advanced treatment plant. On July 7, 2020, the City Council approved a contract with HASA, Inc. (HASA), for the chemical supply of sodium hypochlorite.

HASA has been very accommodating and excellent to work with over the past year, considering the wastewater treatment plant's state of construction and the challenges presented.

HASA has submitted pricing for the next fiscal year, with a slight cost increase due to supply and manufacturing constraints, as well as inflationary pressure throughout the supply chain with upward trends on labor and transportation costs. The following table illustrates the original bid pricing and the current proposed pricing for FY2022.
