RE: KDOT Agreement. 53<sup>rd</sup> Street from Woodlawn to Oliver Multi-Use Path Agreement

### BACKGROUND:

The City applied for grant funding in 2023 to WAMPO for assistance in constructing a multi-use path along 53<sup>rd</sup> Street from Woodlawn to Oliver. The City was awarded a grant and the Agreement for this work is attached.

### DISCUSSION:

This agreement between the City and KDOT sets forth the terms under which KDOT will administer the 53<sup>rd</sup> Street Multi-Use path and puts the funding mechanisms in place. Ideally, this agreement would have been executed months ago, but KDOT was waiting on information from FHWA following the change in Administration.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS: The cost of the improvements for this project will be financed through a general obligation bond.

RECOMENDATION: It is the recommendation of staff to enter into the agreement with KDOT for the grant funds to complete this project.
