No public display permit shall be approved unless the applicant furnishes a certificate of public liability insurance for the display in a minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 for each occurrence including damage to vehicles, naming the City as additional insured and providing for both workers compensation, which is written by an insurance carrier licensed to do business in Kansas. Insurance certificate shall not be cancelled by insured or insurer until written notice is provided to the City Clerk of the City. In the event of cancellation of the insurance prior to the display, the public display permit shall automatically be revoked and void. Presenting a fireworks display after insurance has been cancelled shall be a violation of this code and may be prosecuted as an unclassified misdemeanor.

LOCATION INSPECTION - It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal to schedule an inspection of the display area.

Prior to issuance of a permit, an inspection shall be conducted of the applicant's facility and of each specific area where fireworks are to be sold or displayed to ensure compliance with this Ordinance and other applicable laws. No permit shall be issued for any premises or area not in compliance with such laws. Each location where fireworks are to be sold or displayed shall be inspected by, and subject to the standards imposed by, the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal. A permit may be issued only upon proof that the premises and designated display or sales areas have passed the required inspection by the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal.

SECURITY - All costs of security or additional policing requirements shall be borne by the event operator.

The Chief of Police shall review the application to determine whether police or security shall be required as a condition of approval of the public display permit. Such review shall include determination of traffic control concerns, and identifying and preventing concerns arising from individuals watching the display in unsafe areas located off the display grounds.

OTHER REGULATIONS (Bel Aire City Code Chapter 6, Article 4)

- No public display permit shall be issued if in the opinion of the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal the location, nature of the fireworks or any other relevant factor creates a hazard, risk of harm, or risk of damage to persons or property.
- Prior to approval of any public display permit application, the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal shall have the power to issue reasonable rules and regulations for the granting of said public display permit. City law enforcement and the Sedgwick County Fire Marshal are authorized to terminate a fireworks display event if the event operator or party responsible for fireworks detonation violates any such rules and regulations.
- Only those people actually approved as operators by the Fire Marshal shall handle or discharge any fireworks at such a public display.
- The permittee shall remove all trash and debris from the property associated with the display, including debris generated by the display itself and by attendees. All trash and debris shall be removed no later than 10:00 p.m. on the day following the public display.

FIREWORKS DISPLAY SITE DIAGRAM

A diagram of the grounds on which the display is to be held must be attached to this application.

The diagram must indicate distances from the point of discharge of fireworks to:

- The perimeter of the grounds,
- to all structures located upon the grounds,
- all structures on abutting properties within 500 feet of the point of discharge,
- all abutting streets points of ingress/egress to the grounds, and
- the area at which the audience will be located.
- The date, time and duration of the display.
- The nature or kind of fireworks to be used.
- The name of the person, firm or corporation that will make the actual discharge of the fireworks.
- The name of the person, firm or corporation that will discharge the fireworks. Must present a valid firework operator certificate issued by the State of Kansas Fire Marshal's Office.
- Anticipated need for police, fire or other municipal services.
