RE: KDOT 45th Street, Oliver to Woodlawn Agreement

BACKGROUND:

The City has been awarded funding through WAMPO for the reconstruction of 45th Street between Oliver and Woodlawn. This project will be administered through KDOT. This Agreement covers the terms and conditions of the administration of the 45th Street project and the roles and responsibilities of each organization.

DISCUSSION:

The City was awarded federal funding for the 45th Street Reconstruction project by WAMPO. The Agreement under consideration is what gives KDOT the authority to administer the 45th Street Reconstruction project for the City of Bel Aire. KDOT is responsible for ensuring that the project adheres with Federal rules and regulations. The Agreement sets out KDOT responsibilities, financial considerations as they stand now, City responsibilities and general federal requirements that this project will need to adhere to.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS: There are no financial implications for entering into this agreement with KDOT. Once the project is bid, the City will have an opportunity to decide whether or not to continue with the project based on the project costs.

POLICY DECISION: Council needs to consider entering into an agreement with KDOT in order to proceed with the administration of the 45th Street, Oliver to Woodlawn project.

RECOMENDATION: It is the recommendation of staff to enter into the agreement with KDOT for the administration of this project.
