Plat of M^cClures Addition to the town of Bellbrook. Laid out and adjoining the town of Bellbrook in Greene Co by John M^cClure Proprietor. the Plat commences at a stone at the NE corner of Lot No 1 which was planned by my direction at the intersection of the south line of 1st Alley with the west line of West Street of the Present Town. Alleys No 9, 10, 11, & 12 are each 12ft wide and run North & South 1st Alley is 12ft wide and 3rd Alley is 33ft wide both bearing East and West all the alleys are laid out corresponding to as extension of Alleys of the present Town the front and depth of each lot is indicated by feet on the plat the lots lying South of 3rd Alley corresponding in width to those lying opposite. Given under my hand this 12th day of June 1841 Moses Colier Surveyor G.C.O.
