PURPOSE AND BACKGROUND:

Upon conducting the process for determining priorities in the community for use of available ARPA funds, storm water management came in as the highest priority. A review of the areas with the most frequent issues revealed Lower Hillside as one of those locations.

Engineering has been conducted and identified a solution to help improve the drainage of storm water from the street and neighborhood. It is estimated the project will cost \$200,000 which includes milling and repaving the roadway as opposed to asphalt patch and repair.

This Resolution authorized the bud process which, if approved, is expected to be released first part of July. Once bids are received and reviewed, the recommended bidder will be brought for Council approval.
