#### Ordinance No. 2023-O-5

AMENDING ORDINANCE 2022-O-10 BY MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR EXPENSES OF THE CITY OF BELLBROOK FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2023 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2023, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Bellbrook adopted the 2023 annual budget based on the best information available at the time; and

WHEREAS, additional costs and/or adjustments are required for various 2023 Personnel Services and Other Expenses which requires the amendment of various appropriation levels.

### Now, Therefore, the City of Bellbrook Hereby Ordains:

- Section 1. That to provide for the required expenses and other expenditures of the City of Bellbrook during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023, the appropriation levels are amended as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and hereby set aside to be appropriated.
- Section 2. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary to meet a public emergency affecting health, safety, morals or the public welfare, or a special emergency in the operation of a Municipal department, and for the further reason that repairs to the museum building and data storage for police records is needed as soon as practical; therefore, this Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon its adoption by Council
- Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including, but not limited to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
