

1 **RESOLUTION NO. 21-09**

2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA**  
3 **AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL NON-AD VALOREM**  
4 **SOLID WASTE COLLECTION ASSESSMENT; AND PROVIDING AN**  
5 **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

7 **WHEREAS**, the City of Belle Isle, Florida, provides solid waste collection services to  
8 residential properties within the corporate boundaries of the City by contract with private waste  
9 management companies; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the City has by Ordinance 09-15 levied an annual non-ad valorem solid  
11 waste collection assessment against all residential developed real property located within the  
12 City boundaries; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Chapter 28, Article V, Section 28-202 of the Belle Isle Code of Ordinances  
14 provides that the amount of the solid waste service assessment in any fiscal year shall be  
15 determined by the rates, fees and charges established by the City solid waste agreement; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the City has by Ordinance 19-06 entered into a contract for waste collection  
17 and recycling services with JJ's Waste and Recycling; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Section 26 of the contract allows for a modification to rates by JJ's Waste  
19 and Recycling, in accordance with the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for the immediate  
20 preceding 12-month period, capped at the amount of the increase in the CPI or three percent  
21 (3%), whichever is lower; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the 12 month average CPI for Water, Sewer and Trash Collection Services  
23 shows an average increase of 3.40%; and

24 **WHEREAS**, JJ's Waste and Recycling submitted their request for a 3% rate increase to  
25 the City on May 27, 2021; and
