

**CITY OF BELLE ISLE
RESOLUTION NO. 22-12**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS AND RELATED SIGNAGE) AT THE INTERSECTION OF MCCOY ROAD AND VIA FLORA IN THE CITY OF BELLE ISLE AND PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, § 316.006(2)(a), Florida Statutes, provides that chartered municipalities shall have original jurisdiction over all streets and highways located within their boundaries, except state roads, and may place and maintain such traffic control devices which conform to the manual and specifications of the Department of Transportation upon all streets and highways under their original jurisdiction as they shall deem necessary to indicate and to carry out the provisions of this chapter or to regulate, warn, or guide traffic, and;

WHEREAS, the intersection of McCoy Road and Via Flora are within the city limits of the City of Belle Isle and;

WHEREAS, in considering the placement and types of signage to be installed pursuant to this Resolution, City of Belle Isle staff has taken the following factors into account: volume of traffic, distance from other traffic control devices, speed of traffic, visibility at the intersection, lane configuration, and the character of the area being mostly residential, and;

WHEREAS, numerous requests have been received by the City of Belle Isle from citizens to install stop signs at the intersection, and;

WHEREAS, the City staff has informed the Belle Isle City Council, and the Belle Isle City Council agrees, that it is prudent and in the best interest of the traveling public to install certain signs at the locations identified in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Belle Isle, Florida, that:

SECTION 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. Installation of Signage. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs city staff to install or cause to be installed the following types of signage in accordance with the FDOT Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices promulgated by Rule 14-15.010, F.A.C. at the locations identified below:

1. Installation of stop signs (R1-1) on Via Flora for northbound and southbound traffic at the McCoy Road intersection.
2. Installation of a stop sign (R1-1) on McCoy Road for westbound traffic at the Via Flora intersection. This will result in an "ALL-WAY" stop at such intersection.
3. Installation of "ALL WAY" plaques (RI-3P) below each stop sign at the intersection of Via Flora and McCoy Road.
4. Installation of stop ahead signs (W3-1), for westbound traffic on McCoy Road approximately 500 feet east of the Via Flora intersection.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, word or provision of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, whether for substantive, procedural, or any other reason, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. Conflicts. In the event of a conflict or conflicts between this Resolution and any other resolution or provision of law, this Resolution governs and controls to the extent of the conflict, as allowable under the law.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption by the City Council of the City of Belle Isle, Florida.
